## What is SWAT?

SWAT is a medically accurate interactive presentation for middle and high school students with a simple goal:

*Empowering this generation to set high standards and avoid risky behaviors, thereby avoiding the significant physical, psychological, social, and financial consequences of at-risk sexual activity.*

S.W.A.T. (Speaking Words of Absolute Truth) is dedicated to educating teens to make the healthiest choice for their future. SWAT presentations holistically empower teens to accomplish their goals, set high relationship expectations, and develop character. The youth are equipped through the concepts presented to identify risks, master their refusal skills, and point out healthy and unhealthy relationship characteristics common in today's culture.

## Where SWAT is Used?

SWAT presentations are best suited for classroom type environments or medium size youth gatherings, approximately 50– 75 students. S.W.A.T. is currently presented in both public and private schools. Each presentation lasts approximately 50 minutes, the length of a typical class period. Each presentation is designed to be age and gender appropriate for the audience being addressed.

SWAT presentations are currently presented annually in the North Atlanta area, teaching over 15,000 students per year.

SWAT presentations are not intended to replace the required sex education curriculum presented in the public schools. The presentations compliment the required curriculum. The trained presenters are required to have a college degree, an understanding of the SWAT approach, and experience presenting a sexual health message in today's teen culture. The purpose of this approach is to collaborate efforts between the public schools, health teachers, and solid community organizations that specialize in sexual health and reducing unplanned pregnancy and the spread of sexually transmitted infections amongst the teen population.

## How SWAT Affiliation Works:

SWAT presentations can be accessed through a yearly subscription and are available in Prezi format. Prezi is web-based software where presentations can be accessed through a free personal account. Presentations are maintained and regularly updated by the SWAT team, to ensure the material is always visually appealing, culturally up to date and medically accurate.

Access to the presentations can be purchased on a year to year basis, per an annual fee of **\$1,200**. Additional one-time training fees are required upon initiation of the annual agreement.

All SWAT material is under copyright protection, and may not be edited, shared, or reproduced in any form or fashion from the original format. An Annual Usage Agreement, defining terms of use must be signed by any participating organization or individual prior to gaining access to the SWAT presentations.




